



Welcome Back!

We are delighted to welcome you back to Towradgi Park Bowls & Recreation Club.

Our Members & Guests will have access to all our facilities to enjoy. We have spent time over the last few weeks ensuring we have everything in place to keep our visitors safe at all times.

This notice will outline the rules and regulations we have in place to ensure a smooth opening transition and to help us in preventing the spread of Covid-19.

Please be aware that capacity restrictions of 1 person per 4 square metres do apply, as well as social distancing rules of 1.5 meters between guests at all times.

Under the current guidelines of the NSW Department of Health all patrons (including Members) are required to record their name & contact number in the register located at the Club entry. Minors are exempt from this requirement

While on the premises patrons are to remain seated if not being served and are not to be seen standing around mingling in any area of the Club.

Bookings for dining are not essential. However, it is strongly recommended to book to avoid disappointment. Groups bookings or sizes cannot exceed 10 people as set out by the Government and NSW Health.

Entertainment will not be returning yet, but we will be looking into this more and more as the restrictions continue to ease.

We have introduced hand sanitiser stations throughout our Club for your convenience. We will also have allocated staff to ensure cleaning is completed on a regular basis, particularly through peak times.

We are dedicated to ensuring Members, guests and staff adhere to social distancing and hygiene practices.

If you are sick, stay at home. Although at this stage we will not be doing temperature checks, if showing symptoms you may be refused entry into the Club.

We have introduced additional safety signage throughout our venue to encourage fellow patrons to follow all Government advice.

We're committed to keeping our doors open and that means adhering to all the Government advice and measures. We're doing our utmost to ensure that you can continue to enjoy the Club Facilities.
